Would you like to become a telephone operator for a while?

For this activity, at least three people are required:

- 1. Telephone operator
- 2. Person calling from a transmitter telephone
- 3. Person answering from a receiving telephone

Spread throughout the exhibition, there are four telephones connected by this switchboard: Telephone A, Telephone B, Telephone C and Telephone D.

Would you like to transfer a call from one to another?

How to use the switchboard?

Example of a call from telephone A to telephone B.

Telephone a

1. Dial 09 to connect with the switchboard and request a call to Telephone B.

Operator

- 2. A pilot light will illuminate on the switchboard
- 3. Put on the headset
- 4. Insert the RED plug into the hole of the illuminated light
- 5. Move the YELLOW key forward to talk to **Te-lephone A**.
- 6. Insert the GREEN pin into the hole on Telephone B.
- 7. Move the YELLOW key backwards and turn the BLUE crank clockwise. This will activate the ringing tone of Telephone B.

Telehone B

8. Pick up **Telephone B** to speak to **Telephone A**.

Operator

- 9. Ask **Telephone B** if they want to speak to **Teleho-ne A**.
- 10. Push the YELLOW key to the center position so that Telephone A and Telephone B can now spack.
